## INCOME GUIDELINES FOR EXEMPTION TO CITY OF MILL VALLEY 2024-25 LIBRARY TAX

March 12, 2024

Dear Property Owner,

The following are the Income Guidelines for Exemption to City of Mill Valley 2024-25 Library Tax:

- 1. The property must be owner occupied.
- 2. The total **gross household income** from all sources, including social security, for the 2023 calendar year does not exceed the following:

For a single-person household: \$122,500 For a two-person household: \$140,000 For a three-person household: \$157,500 For a four-person household: \$175,000 For a five-person household: \$189,000

- 3. In order to meet the deadline to qualify for the exemption on your September, 2024-25 tax bill, you must file your request by May 31, 2024.
- 4. **You must reapply each year** to keep the exemption in effect. A form will automatically be sent to those who filed the previous year.

If you qualify, please complete and sign the <u>Declaration of Exemption to City of Mill Valley 2024-25</u> **Library Tax Form** on the reverse side of this page. Once completed, return the form by May 31, 2024 to:
