## **SANITARY SEWER 25% SERVICE FEE CREDIT**

March 12, 2024

Dear Property Owner:

The City is offering a **sanitary sewer 25% service fee credit** for the upcoming 2024/25 property tax bill for those who participate on the PG&E California Alternative Rates for Energy (**CARE**) Program. Please refer to the **PG&E CARE** guidelines on the back of this letter to determine if you qualify for the program. The 25% fee credit is for single-family residents and the discount **does not** apply to apartments, rental units on the property, or businesses.

We are sending this letter to property owners who may qualify for the sewer service fee credit. To continue receiving the credit, **you must reapply each year**.

Please print the Marin County Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) and your phone number on all documents you submit to the City. Your APN is printed on the envelope containing this letter.

## The Sewer Service Fee Credit does not require you to fill out a form.

Please mail either your PG&E bill indicating participation in the CARE Program, <u>OR</u> a copy of the first page of your income tax form filed for 2023, by May 31, 2024 to:

In order to qualify, the PG&E bill must contain your name and your property address.

## QUALIFYING FOR CARE BASED ON HOUSEHOLD INCOME

Add all household members' incomes from all eligible sources for your total gross annual household income. The total combined gross annual household income must be at or below the amounts shown in the following table.
